



Reproductive Health Services

The Reproductive Health Clinic features gynecological services including Pap smears, pelvic exams, pregnancy testing, and STD screening.

Clients meet with the clinic Nurse to fill out paperwork, receive educational materials, and set up an initial appointment with the clinician.

The female reproductive health clinic offers a comprehensive medical history, a reproductive life plan, current pregnancy status, sexual health assessment (STD screening), intimate partner violence, alcohol & other drug use, tobacco use, immunization history, depression assessment, and basic infertility services.

All of the services are based on your household's income and determined based on a sliding scale fee scale. Please bring a current copy of a pay stub from the employed member of your household.

Males can now be seen at the Reproductive Health Clinic for family planning services and related preventative health services including: medical history, sexual health assessment (STD screening), alcohol & drug assessment, tobacco assessment, immunization history, depression assessment, and basic infertility services.

Pregnancy Testing

Need a pregnancy test? Call Monday-Friday 7:30-4:00 for an appointment.

Our clinic Nurse will review the results with you and provide referrals for contraception or pregnancy options.

Pregnancy services are not part of the Reproductive Health and Wellness program we do have prenatal care available at the health department, not covered by RHWP grant funds.

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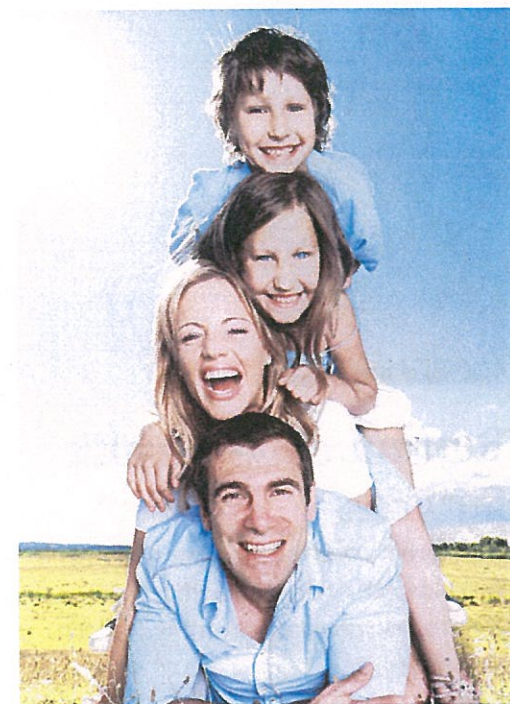
